#### Requests from Laundry Service

It is very important that Laundry within the home is processed efficiently within the home and we know it is frustrating at times when items are not returned to your loved ones rooms. We are now operating a new button system where a button with your loved ones room number is secured onto their clothing to ensure that items are returned to the correct person. Can we please request that if families or friends are bringing in new clothing that they highlight this to the staff on the floor to ensure the buttons can be secured and the clothes are added to the inventory to allow us to keep track of the clothing in the home. On the same note if families or friends are clearing out clothing or taking clothing away can they ask the staff if the buttons can be removed from the clothing prior to them leaving the building to allow for them to be used for any new items that may be received moving forward. We are also going to trial mesh bags for smalls such as socks and underwear which will be placed in these bags and laundered all together instead of each item being marked with separate buttons as the level of buttons being used within the home is vast so please bear with us while we trial this new way of working, however if any issue arises please do not hesitate to discuss with myself or head of hospitality Christine Penman.
